## **LAWN CARE CALENDAR**

MONTH	CARE
APRIL	<ul> <li>Repair damaged areas with a Lawn Repair Kit or Patch.</li> <li>Apply Crabgrass Preventer to established lawns, to stop crabgrass seed from germinating (apply before temps reach 55°F, 3 days in a row).</li> </ul>
MAY	<ul> <li>Seed lawns (can't do if Crabgrass Preventer was applied in April) or lay sod.</li> <li>Fertilize established lawns with No Phosphate lawn food (or Weed and Feed).</li> <li>Begin mowing (not lower than 2½").</li> </ul>
JUNE	<ul> <li>Apply Weed &amp; Feed to established lawns with No Phosphate, if not done in May (weeds should be actively growing, have lawn foliage moist).</li> <li>Mow regularly.</li> </ul>
JULY	<ul> <li>Only irrigated and highly managed lawns can be fertilized this month.</li> <li>Keep mowing!</li> <li>A lawn needs 1" of water per week. Irrigate if no rainfall.</li> </ul>
AUGUST	<ul> <li>Plant seed or lay sod from mid to late August.</li> <li>Repair bare areas with a Lawn Repair Kit or Patch.</li> <li>Irrigate if no rainfall.</li> </ul>
SEPTEMBER	<ul> <li>Early to mid September — can still lay sod or seed new lawns.</li> <li>Fertilize and use a weed killer to get rid of perennial weeds (use No-Phosphate Weed and Feed, or Weed B Gone).</li> </ul>
OCTOBER	<ul> <li>Apply Winterizer or High Nitrogen, Phosphorus free fertilizer. This is the most important fertilizing application for your lawn.</li> </ul>
